

How to Supervise a Bounce House

Before Use — Setup Checklist

- Ensure the unit is fully inflated and all seams are sealed before allowing entry.
- Verify anchor stakes or sandbags are secure at all four corners.
- Inspect the blower motor — do not operate if the motor makes unusual sounds.
- Clear a 6-foot safety perimeter around all sides of the unit.
- Keep the entrance/exit clear of obstacles at all times.

During Use — Supervision Rules

- A responsible adult supervisor must be present and actively watching at ALL times.
- Maximum occupancy: follow the posted limit on the unit label (typically 4–6 children).
- No shoes, sharp objects, jewelry, or eyeglasses inside the bounce house.
- No food, drinks, gum, or silly string allowed inside the unit.
- Keep children of similar size and age together — do not mix toddlers with older kids.
- Prohibit flips, wrestling, or roughhousing.
- One person at a time on the slide attachment, if applicable.

Weather Policy

- Immediately evacuate and power off the unit if winds exceed 15 mph.
- Do not operate in rain, lightning, or thunderstorm conditions.
- In high heat (above 95 °F), take frequent shade and water breaks.

Emergency Procedures

- If the blower fails, calmly guide all children out immediately.
- In case of injury, call 911 first, then contact Ride & Slide Party Co.
- Do not attempt to move or deflate the unit without contacting us first.
