

Mechanical Bull Rider Rules

Eligibility Requirements

- Riders must be at least 7 years old.
- Minimum weight: 40 lbs. Maximum weight: 250 lbs.
- Riders must sign (or have a guardian sign) the liability waiver before riding.
- Pregnant individuals, those with back/neck injuries, or recent surgery must NOT ride.
- Individuals under the influence of alcohol or substances are strictly prohibited.

Before the Ride

- Remove all jewelry, belts, and items from pockets.
- Wear closed-toe shoes — no sandals, flip-flops, or bare feet.
- Secure loose clothing. Long hair should be tied back.
- Sit centered on the saddle and grip the handle with your dominant hand.

During the Ride

- One rider at a time — no spectators on the mat while the bull is in motion.
- The operator controls the speed — do not request dangerous or extreme speeds for children.
- If you feel unsafe, raise your free hand and the operator will stop immediately.
- Lean back slightly to maintain balance; do not lean too far forward.

Operator Responsibilities

- Keep the remote control within reach at all times.
- Start at the lowest speed setting for all new riders.
- Actively watch every rider and stop the machine if the rider appears to lose control.
- No one may be on the mat within 3 feet of the bull while it is operating.
- Inspect the mat before each use — ensure it is fully inflated and positioned correctly.

After Each Ride

- Allow the rider to dismount before the next rider approaches.
- Wipe down the saddle handle with the provided sanitizer wipe between riders.
